Winter Cruise - *January 7, 2023* - Cruise from Dempsey's in Ashton to Guinness Open Gate Brewery in Baltimore for a tour and dinner.

Washington DC Auto Show - *January 20-29, 2023* - Check out the Corvette Club of America display at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center.

Winter Awards Dinner Party - *Late February or Early March* - Join club members for a private dinner. Door prizes and a CCA giveaway, various raffles and silent auction. Presentation of the Dick Thompson Award.

St. Patrick's Day Lunch - *March* - Celebrate St. Patrick's Day at a wonderful Irish restaurant.

Michelin NCM Bash - *April* - The Bash is a mixture of Road Tours to Kentucky Attractions, Presentations by Corvette Celebrities, Product Demonstrations, Technical Seminars, Classroom Sessions with Corvette Technicians, Car Shows, Vendors, the Ladies Oasis, and more.

Spring Brewery Cruise - *April* - Cruise through scenic back-roads to a local brewery.

Olney Days Car Show & Parade - *May* - A local parade celebrating the community of Olney, MD. The parade route is less than a mile and ends in front of the reviewing stand. The CCA took second place in the motorized category in 2019.

Brightview Fallsgrove Corvette Invitational - *May* - The staff at Brightview Senior Living, Fallsgrove invite you to share your Corvette and enjoy a cookout with the residents. This is a free event for members showing their Corvettes and trophies are awarded for best in show.

NCM Le Mans Race Weekend - *June* - Watch the 24 Hours of Le Mans at NCM with fellow CCA members. The NCM is one of just a few locations outside of France that will be given a direct commercial free feed of the race.

Drive Your Corvette to Work Day - Mid America Motorworks has proclaimed that Drive your Corvette to Work Day be celebrated on the Friday closest to June 30th, the day the first 1953 Corvette rolled off the assembly line in Flint, Michigan.

IMSA at Mosport - *Early July* - This is a week-long trip involving a cruise to Ontario and participation in the Corvette Corral. In 2015 the CCA actually won a participation award for having the largest group at the Mosport Corvette Corral.

Founders' Day Anniversary Picnic - *July* - CCA celebrates its 67th anniversary with lunch at a scenic venue.

Car Show at Sport Chevrolet - *Summer or Fall* - CCA's biggest event of the year! Classes for each generation of Corvette. T-shirts and dash plaques for registrants. Cash and trophies to be awarded. Proceeds benefit local charities.

Summit Point HPDE Cruise-In w/ Chin Trackdays - *Early August* - Introduction to HPDE. CCA HPDE instructors give ride-alongs on track at speed and attendees are invited to drive a parade lap in their own car.

Summer Cruise & Lunch or Dinner - *August* - Local cruise to a winery, brewery, distillery, car collection, or museum usually followed by lunch or dinner.

Corvettes at Carlisle - *August 24-26, 2023* - Multi-day car show in PA featuring thousands of Corvettes, hundreds of vendors, a Corvette parade, and much more. The CCA has reserved parking in a prime location and a shared tent. Register for the Fun Field and select "CORV CLUB OF AMERICA" as your club.

Corvette Show & BBQ at Walter Reed - *September* - CCA and USO car show and cookout lunch for the soldiers of the Warrior Transition Brigade, their families, and Walter Reed staff.

NCM Corvette Racing Weekend at AACA Museum - *October* - A two-day celebration dedicated to Corvette Racing hosted by the NCM at the Antique Automobile Club of America Museum in Hershey, PA. Register through the NCM.

Free State Corvette Weekend - *Mid October* - FSCC's annual charity event in Ocean City, MD which includes a boardwalk parade, rallies, fun shows, and more. CCA members coordinate get-togethers between the FSCC events.

Fall Cruise & Lunch or Dinner - *Mid Fall* - Local cruise to a winery, brewery, distillery, car collection, or museum usually followed by lunch or dinner.
